Purpose of Meeting: Fundraising Discussion + Updates

Acknowledgement Fund

This is a fund set aside for condolences. Suggested budget is \$100 (\$50 each offering), for two possible acknowledgements a year. Next PAC meeting in April will formalize this motion.

Technology Fund

Potential items to be covered under this fund are in the realm of technology support items. Kelly had suggested that her school uses hand-mics for teaching which could be a potential technology line item, and other suggestions opened up to the meeting attendees.

Determined that Suncrest administration would typically approach PAC with their 'wants', and PAC would vote on covering the cost for those items, therefore don't need to outline specific criteria for this line item.

Fundraising Goal Update: Water Filter Fountain/Filler Station

Fun Lunch update: profit for hot lunches was \$1,500.00 and \$2,100.00 for the Jan – March period. Labour for installation etc will be covered by Suncrest administration, therefore Suncrest has successfully met the fundraising goal for this item.

Grade 7 Fundraising

Sabrina proposed a Grade 7 Lunch & Dance. She has just recently received the go-ahead that this will be allowed this year. Grade 7 grad committee (ie. Sabrina) has not had the opportunity to

fundraise for this event all year because of the COVID-related uncertainty surrounding if school events will be permitted.

Discussed Grade 7 fund-related possibilities:

- to 'borrow' from another line item in the budget
- take from other fundraising profits, and designate remaining fundraisers for the year to grade 7 grad to replenish what is borrowed
- Annual Gaming Grant
- Grade 7 Parents to donate whatever they can afford

Future fundraisers for the year that can be designated to Grade 7 grad event costs:

- A bottle drive, made possible by volunteer Grade 7 students and parents
- Neufelds/Purdys/Nursery
- Spirit wear + labels

Decided that Sabrina needs to provide an estimated cost of the Lunch & Dance event which will include breakdown of specific elements (photobooth, décor, and food) so that PAC can decide how much to cover.
