| DPAC Report (Gadis) | - April 25 \& May 13 are the extra Pro-D additions. <br> - New speaker Salima Noon gives sexual education presentations to schools or classes. Lessons are tailored to curriculum levels. Ultimate goal is to get children to understand what is safe, and what is OK or not right to talk about, and how to communicate unsafe situations. <br> - Discussion about PAC funded events and parent decisions vs. teacher/school decisions. <br> - (Andrew) If decisions are made during PAC that affects in-school time, it has to go through the teachers, even if it is PAC funded. <br> - Every year DPAC has a school visits. <br> - This happened at our school last year and occurs every other year at our school. When it occurred last year, a principal from the district attended, someone from DPAC, and some people from our PAC were present. | Treasurer's <br> Report <br> (Rebecca) | - (Treasurer) We have a budget, and have an invoice from district this year for $\$ 1900.16$. Two years ago the district has invoiced us $\$ 1234.20$. Discussion about the allocation of funds for the jump math and who will be paying for the invoice. <br> - (Andrew) No resources from the school were allocated to Jump Math this year based on the decision from last year to use. | From Feb $10^{\text {th }}$ moving forward, any large expenditures or allocations of funds over \$500 need to have a motion for use and approval. |


|  | - (Treasurer) PAC agrees to cover the cost as there is a budget line allocations are available under "Supplementary Work Books." <br> - (PAC members) Discussion about wording of "Supplementary Work Books" and what it includes. Action to discuss this further. <br> - (Andrew) Art Starts catalogue comes out in Spring for events starting in September of that year (continuing into June of that school year). It costs between $\$ 600-\$ 1400$, depending on the event. Will approach teachers and PAC with ideas to give time for future budgeting. <br> - (Gadis) Grade 7 fundraiser funds seem to have discrepancy. (Rebecca) One fundraising there was GST missing, and one order was missing or mis-calculated by accident. Current amounts are correct. <br> - (Gadis) Question about funds for grade 7 graduation. (Rebecca \& Corina) Confirmed that \$20/student from gaming funds from PAC. Students also do their own fundraising for events and grad. <br> - Discussion by PAC members about grade 7 fundraiser ideas. <br> - Discussion by PAC about what can be included food related to sell to kids for fundraisers. (Corina) There is a health booklet to be referred to for direct student sales during school hours. (Andrew) After school or other events don't have to follow this, only in-school direct sales to students. <br> - PAC fundraising checklist is being worked on and will be put in place for people to use in the future.
