Treasurer's Report	 Not a lot of change from last report. After money set aside for playground and earthquake, there is about \$8500. Money still needs to be paid for hot lunches, and is always on an ongoing basis so it's hard to make exact numbers with ongoing lunches. Got a cheque from Big Brothers from clothing donation, total of \$97.50 Will be a clothing drive in May, leftover clothes after sales will go to Big Brothers if there is enough left-over for Big Brothers (10 bags minimum) Movie night was a success, \$400 for movie license, made \$500, so \$100 profit. There will be 2-3 more movie nights, so the rest of the proceeds will be a profit. Supplementary resource funds need to be used by end of April to receive reimbursement. A few more field trips need to be submitted and reimbursed. Burnaby golf has a free day of lessons for intermediate students.
