Principal's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assembly on respect and proper audience management went well. Many children are phoning home and some have signed themselves out without adult permission. Some incidences of students phoning home are not appropriate, and they need to be safe, so phone has been taken off the desk. They need teacher's or adult's permission to use the phone and adult to be there. Student office monitors (recess & lunch) have been asked to seek out a staff member before students call home Reason to call home: serious illness or injury. Most other concerns can be managed at school. Young children are encouraged to have a full change of clothes at school in case of an accident or getting really wet/muddy outside. All students to have proper seasonal clothing for outside. Students not to call home to arrange play dates, ask when you are coming to pick them up, for minor requests – forgotten homework, instruments, etc. We are encouraging responsibility and resilience...slightly damp pants will dry soon, sometimes a rest and some water will make you feel better, you can make it through the day if you are feeling a little under the weather – this is especially true for our older students Need a decision on internet safety.
